GOLD CIRCLE INDUCTEE HARRY BOOMER

Harry, who attended Northern Virginia Community College in Alexandria, Va., has called Greater Cleveland home since 1990. He is proud to live in the historic Hough neighborhood in Cleveland. He was honored in 2015 to be selected as a member of Silver Circle of National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences.

In 2014, Boomer was honored to be named as a History Maker. His life's story in now a part of the National Archives, a permanent repository of American History.

Harry Boomer is a 2007 Broadcasters Hall of Fame Inductee.

Harry is currently the morning and noon Anchor/Reporter at 19 Action News and he also is the Executive Producer and Host of WUAB 43 Forum, a public affairs program covering community issues. Boomer is a valued member of the WOIO CBS 19 Editorial Board. Harry Boomer has the distinction of being the longest, continuous on air-air anchor/reporter on both WOIO CBS 19 and WUAB My 43. Harry is a past President of the Greater Cleveland Association of Black Journalists (GCABJ). He is also a member of the Board of Directors of The First Tee Cleveland, a program that promotes nine core positive values for youth through the game of golf.

His career began in Washington, D.C., where he was a club DJ, an on-air personality, talk show host and he served in various management positions, including two stints as news director, including one as news director for Radio One.

Harry came to Ohio in 1988 to manage and program WBXT-AM in Canton. While covering assignments for WOIO/WUAB on a part-time basis in the early 1990s, Harry was heard regularly on WCPN-90.3 FM/ Idea Stream, where he had been assistant news director. He was also a reporter, producer and major contributor to National Public Radio. Among other things, Harry debuted a statewide news magazine program entitled "Infohio" for the radio station. Increased full-time duties at 19 Action News notwith-standing, Harry's familiar voice was heard on a freelance basis for public radio specials on WCPN. Boomer was a regular guest on the Feagler and Friends on Cleveland Public Television, Idea Stream WVIZ. He has served on the board of the Ohio Associated Press. He is former member of the Board of Directors of Connections, Health, Wellness (formerly North East Ohio Health Services). Boomer has also served on the board of The Ohio Center for Broadcasting. He is also a member of the Continuing Education Committee at Cleveland State University.

Harry has won awards from the Ohio Associated Press, Ohio Educational Telecommunications, Women in Communications, the Press Club of Cleveland and the National Association of Black Journalists.

Harry is active in the community, often serving as master of ceremonies at events throughout northeast Ohio. When he's not working (which isn't often), he enjoys talking politics and visiting friends and family around the country. Boomer is a proud father. He has two wonderful grandchildren. Harry is truly a Baby Boomer. His last name really is Boomer. He's the baby of a family of ten and he is a member of the Baby Boom Generation.



GOLD CIRCLE INDUCTEE LEON BIBB

Leon Bibb is a popular newscaster in Cleveland with decades of experience. In semi-retirement, He is currently working as a senior reporter and commentator for WKYC-TV3. He began his career at that NBC television station in 1979 and worked there for 16 years before moving to WEWS-TV5, the ABC station in Cleveland, where he worked for 22 years. At both television stations, Leon Bibb served as a news anchor and a reporter for all the major newscasts. In 2018, he joined WKYC-TV where, although in semi-retirement, he serves as a senior reporter and commentator where he offers his viewpoints on the passing scene.

Before his career in Cleveland television, Leon worked as a news anchor and reporter in Columbus and Toledo and as a reporter for the Plain Dealer newspaper in Cleveland. He is a graduate of the School of Journalism at Bowling Green State University where he also studied Radio-TV-Film in the graduate school.

Mr. Bibb is a graduate of Bowling Green State University where he studied journalism and broadcasting. Early in his career, he was a reporter for the Cleveland Plain Dealer newspaper. Throughout his career, he has covered stories throughout the United States. He has also covered international stories including the Persian Gulf War. He has interviewed President Barack Obama in a one-on-one interview conducted at the White House. He also interviewed President George H.W. Bush at the White House. Among other notable interviews are those of astronaut Neil Armstrong, first man to walk on the moon. Mr. Bibb also conducted a prison interview of James Earl Ray, convicted assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

Among his many reports has been a series of more than 300 stories entitled "My Ohio with Leon Bibb" which was about interesting people, places, and things in the state. Leon has had a passion for journalism since he was in elementary school.

Mr. Bibb is the recipient of many journalism awards. He has won television's coveted Emmy award seven times and has been nominated this year for five additional Emmys for his reports and commentaries.

Leon Bibb is a veteran of the U.S. Army where he served in the war in Vietnam and was awarded the Army's Bronze Star Medal for Meritorious Service in combat.

An accomplished writer, actor, and narrator of audio books, he has authored one book nearing publication and is currently writing a novel. He and his wife, Marguerite, live in Shaker Heights.



GOLD CIRCLE INDUCTEE BOB HAMMER

Bob Hammer transitioned from theatre to broadcasting in 1966 at KAKE-TV in his hometown of Wichita, Kansas where he served as Studio Lighting Director, Stage Manager & Cameraman. At the ripe old age of 20, Bob was promoted to Producer/ Director of the 6 and 10 PM newscasts. As Wichita did not have any major league sports, Bob developed the televising of little league baseball games shot on the backlot of the studio.

In 1971, Bob, 23, was recruited to Toledo's WTOL-TV as Senior Commercial Producer/Director. He successfully built a following of advertising agencies and direct commercial clients. He received numerous awards for corporate programming and produced and directed basketball broadcasts for Bowling Green State University and The University of Toledo.

Bob was appointed Creative Services Director for WBBH-TV, Ft. Myers, Florida in 1975. In only 18 months, he was directly responsible for a 300% increase in the station's commercial productions. Many of the filmed commercials won awards in Miami, Florida.

The following year, Bob joined UAB Productions, Cleveland, Ohio. His award-winning commercial work and direct-response infomercials have been seen around the world. His live and taped special events programs have received Gold Awards in the New York International Film Festival.


Hammer Production Company was founded in 1993, and rapidly became a full-time video production and internet web design business serving clients from Canada to Florida.

Building on that success, he was invited to produce the Emmy Awards programs in 1982, 1985, 1990 and 1995. Bob joined the Board of Governors in 1992 and served as the Chapter's Emmy Awards Chair, Job Bank Coordinator, and Finance Chair. In 1998, Bob was inducted into the Silver Circle Society in the Cleveland Chapter. In 2001, he was elected Chapter President, followed by 8 years as a National Trustee where he led the name change from Cleveland Chapter to Lower Great Lakes chapter to be more inclusive of the regional membership.

Bob was appointed Awards Administrator as the chapter transitioned from printed forms and video tapes to Emmy Express. He was asked to become the Executive Director of the chapter 5 years ago.

Bob is also civic minded having served on many of the Mayor's committees in Berea, Ohio. He spent 20 years heavily involved with leadership in the YMCA. Bob is an active member of the Berea Rotary Club and a Rotary International Paul Harris Fellow.



GOLD CIRCLE INDUCTEE CARL MONDAY

As the "Dean" of Cleveland investigative reporters, Carl Monday has set the standard for investigative journalism in Cleveland. In a career that has spanned seven decades, Monday has been a trail-blazer in the field, from the voice on all-news radio... to heading up investigative units at three Cleveland television stations.

A long-time member of the NATAS-Central Great Lakes Board of Directors, Monday currently serves as the Cleveland Vice-President of the NATAS Board and is co-chair of the Board's Marketing Committee.

During his career, Monday has captured more than 150 national, regional and local awards. His thirteen EMMYS for Investigative Reporting are tops in local EMMY history. His 50 total EMMYS include statues for Breaking News, News Writing and Crime Reporting.

Monday was also the first television reporter inducted into the Cleveland Press Club Hall of Fame. With his ever present trench coat and aggressive reporting style, Monday's reports have appeared on CBS and CNN and other national outlets. He was a regular in-studio guest on "Geraldo" and the CBS Prime Time magazine show "Shame on You!"

Monday was one of the first reporters to expose the deadly problem of "Sudden Acceleration" in vehicles. His stories caught the attention of CBS "60 Minutes," who flew a producer to Cleveland to consult with Monday for a follow-up story that aired on the iconic news program.

Monday's investigation into corruption in the Cleveland fire Department's inspection unit led to to the firing of the City's Fire Marshall, and garnered Monday the "National Headliner Award" for Investigative Reporting.

At Kent State, in wake of the May 4th tragedy, Monday served as a correspondent for dozens of radio and TV stations across the country, while working for the University News Service.

In 1979, Monday was hired by WJW-TV, where he spent the next 22 years as the "I-Team Reporter." News Director Virgil hired Monday without ever viewing an audition tape, after listening to his reports "on the way to work each morning." In 2001, Monday moved to WKYC-TV. He spent six years at the station as "Cleveland's Investigative Reporter." While at Channel 3, Monday won many "Best of Gannett" awards. In 2007, Monday switched to WOIO-TV, where his investigations aired for the next dozen years. He was also a member of the WOIO-TV Editorial Board, penning over 75 of the station's editorials.

Monday's career began while still a high school teenager, airing newscasts on a Cleveland FM radio station. Fifty-three years later, his legendary career continues into his 70's, as a "Contributing Reporter" for the WJW Fox-8 I-Team.

Monday is active with several non-profit organizations, including the Greater Cleveland Food Bank and Downtown Historic Warehouse District.



SILVER CIRCLE INDUCTEE LINDA JACKSON

Linda Jackson graduated from Indiana University in Bloomington with a Bachelor's degree in Journalism.

She co-anchors the Fort Wayne's NBC evening newscasts at 5, 6 and 11.

Linda also enjoys working with several area nonprofits and getting to meet people from our community who have some of the biggest hearts anywhere.

Linda served as a news intern at NBC33 in Fort Wayne while in college. She began her broadcast journalism career in The Fort as a producer and reporter before becoming an anchor. She has worked all shifts and has also served as a newsroom manager numerous times.

Linda is a 2022 Silver Circle inductee for the Great Lakes Emmy Region of the NATAS organization.

Linda is also a 2020 inductee into the Indiana Pioneers Richard M. Fairbanks Hall of Fame which is part of the Indiana Broadcasters Association.

Linda and several other members of the Fort Wayne's NBC News team received a 2018 Regional Emmy Award for best weekend newscast and their coverage of the April Tinsley Tragedy. The entire Fort Wayne's NBC team received a 2018 Regional Emmy Award for Overall Excellence.

Linda has received several other industry awards from the Indiana News Photographers Association, Indiana Society of Professional Journalists and the Indiana Associated Press. She was named INAP Best Reporter of 2018 for stories on the Fort Wayne opioid epidemic and how it plays out on the streets and in the courts, the Peru, Indiana Youth Circus and her feature "Happy Birthday Henry" about a young Riley Hospital patient from Fort Wayne.

Linda is the 2018 recipient of the Indiana Judges Association first place award for her story on the opioid epidemic in Fort Wayne. She is a Poynter Institute honors graduate, a "Future 40" award recipient from the Fort Wayne Business Journal and a first place Indiana Hospital and Health Association award-winner for her series, "A Gift for Peggy." She also received a first place award in 2005 from the INAP for "A Gift for Peggy." Readers of the Fort Wayne Journal Gazette and "Whatzup" have voted Linda "Best TV Station Personality" several times.

Linda enjoys broadcast journalism because it's a "people business" and because she's part of a team that strives for fairness and facts. She chose her career because of that and because of the visual images that go hand in hand in delivering broadcast news, not to mention the immediacy of the medium. She enjoys meeting new people and the variety in her job. No two days are the same!

Fort Wayne is home for Linda, her husband and their son. They love it here and appreciate the kindness of people. She is originally from Peru, Indiana. Several of her family members live there. She grew up performing in the Peru Amateur Circus spending several years flying on a trapeze! Her interests include reading, traveling, sports, circuses and exercise.



SILVER CIRCLE INDUCTEE CHUCK LOFTON

Chuck has been part of 13 News Sunrise since the very first show in September of 1985. For decades families, students and Hoosiers of every walk of life have started their day with his forecasts. He is also a part of Indiana morning radio. His forecasts have been heard on the award winning "Jim, Deb and Kevin" show on WFMS-FM in Indy since 2000. He appeared on the morning show on WLBC in Muncie from 1987-2000.

Winner of 2 regional Edward R Murrow awards, a national Society of Professional Journalists award and multiple regional Emmy awards, Chuck was named Broadcaster Of The Year by the National Weather Association in 2007. He has covered everything from tornadoes and snow storms to the 2017 lunar eclipse. His feature reporting has taken him from coverage of the

Royal Wedding of Prince Harry and Megan Markle to interesting spots around the country with his Chuck's Big Adventure franchise.

Before coming to WTHR, he was a meteorologist, anchor and reporter for WFIE-TV in Indianapolis. He has also called play by play of college basketball, football and baseball and been part of WTHR's Indy 500 coverage since 1986.

A frequent speaker to churches, schools and organizations he has been named a Prodigy of Indianapolis for community service. He has also been a Master of Ceremonies for events ranging from the Indianapolis Symphony to fundraisers for the Eiteljorg Museum, the American Heart Association, Damar Centers, Community Health Foundation, the Indy Prayer Breakfast and many more. He has hosted the Good News Open golf tournament for 20 years that has raised hundreds of thousands of dollars for the Good News Mission. He serves as the voice of the 500 Festival parade and participates in many other month of May activities. Also he has served on several boards including the Salvation Army of Central Indiana and Kingsway Christian School.

A graduate of Southern Illinois University, he was named an Honorary Alumnus of Taylor University in 2010 and was awarded a Presidential Citation from Indiana Wesleyan University in 2018.

SILVER CIRCLE INDUCTEE LISA LOWRY

Growing up, my family always watched the news. My parents had the Today Show on every morning while we were getting ready for school. We are an NBC family! My interest in television news really started at Brush High School in Lyndhurst (where I grew up) when my two buddies and I were assigned an audio/visual project during our senior year.(WAY BEFORE CAMCORDERS, I PHONES, ETC) We visited Channel 3 to spend a day in the newsroom. Well, when I left the station, I told everyone that I was going to work there one day.

I went onto earn a communications degree at John Carroll University where I took a class instructed by Dom Cameron, WKYC's station manager. As luck would have it, Cameron needed an intern for his news special projects unit. I gladly took the internship and worked with an amazing reporter Ed Miller and photojournalist Bill Gedde. The assignments focused on resarchf or various projects on being an investigation into the safety of carnival rides. Bill Miller went on to be a correspondent

for various national news programs and Gedde of course is Barbara Walters and The View's Executive Producer. I learned from the best!

I enjoyed interning at the station so much that when Dick Feagler needed an intern for his show, I ran at the chance! From The Feagler Show I went on to be the first inern to work on and to help create the children's show "Hickory Hideout", which eventually became an NBC syndicated program.

When I graduated JCU in May of 1982, I was offered a job at the assignment desk the day after my last final. I took it! I started on the overnight shift and helped with Today in Cleveland with Tom Haley and Del Donahue. Forty years late, I remain on the assignment desk, at least I am not on the overnight shift anymore!

Over the years, I have been inducted into the Press Club Hall of Fame and have earned ten regional Emmy Awards. Our coverage of the Chardon High School shooting in February of 2012 later earned WKYC a SPJ award.

My tenure at WKYC has given me the opportunity to work with some of the best journalists in the business. I have trained and mentored many co-workers and interns (hey, that's where I started!) many of which still work in the business and some, like me, were hired right after college graduation!

I am a graduate of Leadership Geauga. I have served on the board of Leadership Geauga and the Press Club of Cleveland. I am graduate of the FBI Citizens Academy.

I am very lucky to have a loving and supportive family as well as co-workers and others in journalism that have been there for me all of these years. I have built strong lifelong friendships that began on the day I started at WKYC. Who knows what the next forty years will bring! $10\,$

Fortunately, my early interest in broadcasting was fully encouraged by the pioneer television program set up by the Parma Public Schools at Normandy High School in the mid-70's. The Parma Instructional Television program was issued the first instructional television license in the State of Ohio and was led by the incredibly talented Phil Stella and James Bailey. in 1976, at the age of 16, I was working in a full studio setting, complete with color cameras, 1 inch video tape capabilities and performing in instructional shows that were being broadcast statewide. Stella ran Parma ITV in an extremely professional way and gave me the discipline and work ethic I needed during the one-of-akind program.

After my 1977 graduation from Normandy High School, I was focused on television production

and the Ohio University telecommunications curriculum and the hundreds of hours I spent volunteering at WOUB-TV was exactly what I needed. It was yet another professional environment that got me prepared for the next 41 years in commercial broadcasting, when I landed my first job upon graduation from Ohio University in 1981.

It was a thrill to be able to work at the television station I grew up watching, when News 5 legend Garry Ritchie hired me onto the production crew at WEWS. Ritchie gave me the chance to work with northeast Ohio television icons like Dorothy Fuldheim, Fred Griffith, Ted Henry, Don Webster and Wilma Smith. In addition to working on WEWS news broadcasts, I had the opportunity to work on classic shows like Polka Varieties and The Morning Exchange.

But it was in 1984 that my journalism career really got its start, and it was Ted Henry who was the biggest catalyst in making it a reality. Watching Ted work behind the scenes was a true inspiration, and it was Ted who gave me the encouragement and the tutelage needed to make it happen. Ted took the time to review the audition tapes I created with the help of gracious News 5 photojournalists, and Cleveland reporting icon Paul Orlousky, who allowed me use some of his video stories.

I was able to get my first on-air television job at WYTV in Youngstown, Ohio, and work with two Mahoning Valley broadcasting legends Jack Bowe and Tom Mock. As a cub reporter, I had absolutely no experience, but was blessed to basically have Mock teach me everything I needed to make the transition from TV production into journalism.

I unexpectedly got a call from WANE-TV Fort Wayne Indiana News Director Bill Wagman in 1987. Wagman saw an audition tape of my work assembled by a hiring firm and asked me to audition to be his anchor for the 6 and 11 PM newscasts, at a time when I had only done anchor fill-in shifts in Youngstown. But, after two wonderful three-year contracts at WANE-TV, my mother started to urge me to come back to northeast Ohio.

Here I am nearly 30-years later, still working in my home community and receiving amazing support from the wonderful people of northeast Ohio, our News 5 viewers, who have trusted me to tell their stories for nearly three decades.


